Start here!

Have a watch of this weeks Worship at Home video together. It gives us some thoughts about our bible study and shows you some examples of our craft this week (**and a little surprise for half term!**)!

Read

Read Matthew 6: 5-13 together. Did you spot something familiar? Were there any words that stood out to you? Have a little chat together about it.

Digging deeper...

Jesus was teaching his disciples HOW to pray, not just giving them a few words to remember and repeat each Sunday. It's easy to just learn and memorise the Lords Prayer without stopping to think too much about what it actually means. It's really juicy with lots of ideas but perhaps you can spot together where it talks about who is most special in the prayer? Who else should we pray for? It talks lots about forgiveness – could you include this in a prayer today?

'Your Kingdom Come' is a really important part for us this week as this is about making sure lots and lots of people come to know about Jesus and ask Him to be their saviour and live their life full of hope and love with Him in it. Can you think of someone you love that you'd love to know Jesus? Include them in your 'Pray 4 Five' activity today!

and we ask for your help to forgive them.

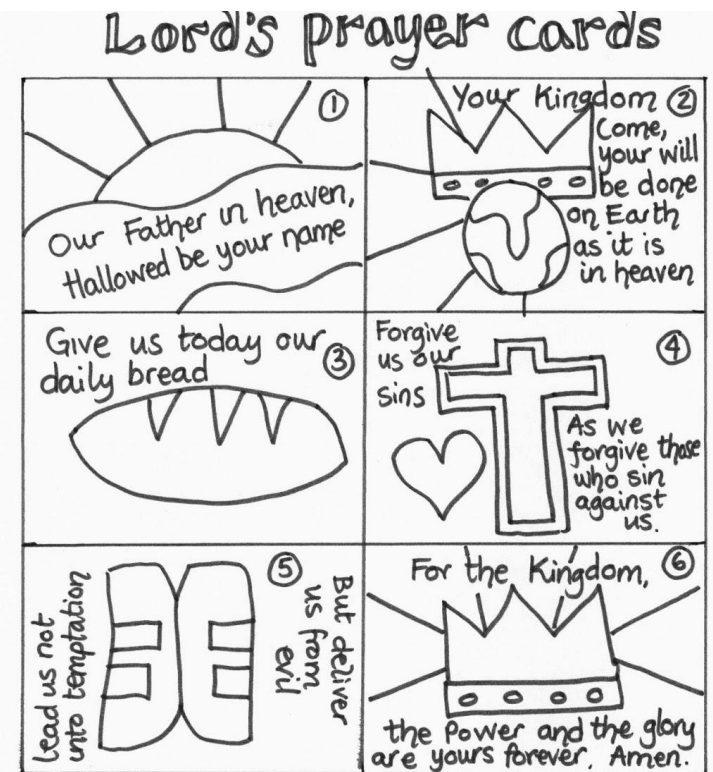
Please keep us away from

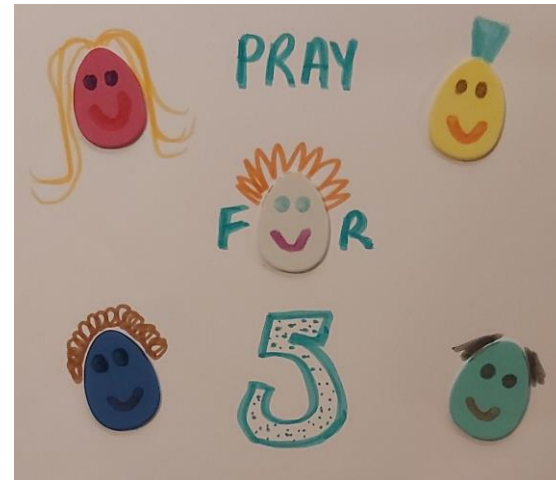




THY KINGDOM COME
