Yes, you've got the right week and no, Valentines Day wasn't postponed! We've got it right that every day should be a day that we reflect on how gigantic and mind blowing our Heavenly Father's love is for us. We're called to overflow with His love in our lives – **how might you reflect this as you go about the week ahead?**

Spent some time reading and reflecting over this passage from 1 John – The New Testament is full of letters and so much of it gives us examples of the ways in which God has and continues to pour out his love on us. Come before God today with a thankful heart and think about what His love means in your life.

God Is Love

⁷⁻¹⁰ My beloved friends, let us continue to love each other since love comes from God. Everyone who loves is born of God and experiences a relationship with God. The person who refuses to love doesn't know the first thing about God, because God *is* love—so you can't know him if you don't love. This is how God showed his love for us: God sent his only Son into the world so we might live through him. This is the kind of love we are talking about—not that we once upon a time loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as a sacrifice to clear away our sins and the damage they've done to our relationship with God.

¹¹⁻¹² My dear, dear friends, if God loved us like this, we certainly ought to love each other. No one has seen God, ever. But if we love one another, God dwells deeply within us, and his love becomes complete in us—perfect love!

STEP 1 Print out or copy the template on the next page


STEP 2 Draw a super colourful design on the back of your template


