Week 2 – "I am The Good Shepherd"

Timings (KS1 video)	Activity	Presented by...	Intended Outcome
0.00-2.55	Welcome and introduction to this weeks theme. (Class to watch video altogether)	Video from Nicola	Children to have a clear understanding on the purpose of the series and what they have to look forward to.
2.55-7.45	Short talk based on the theme of "I am the good shepherd" (John 10) (Class to watch video altogether)	Video from Andy Kennedy (YWAM, Nuneaton)	Children to gain further insight into what Jesus may have meant when he said this statement and how it might apply to their everyday lives now.
7.45-9.25	I wonder questions (A chance to discuss together as a class or small groups/on tables their responses to the questions.)	Video from Nicola, guiding through 3 'I wonder' questions from the talk... Integrated moments to pause for discussion.	Opportunity to discuss their personal reflections on the questions asked.

9.25-12.45	John 10 Story Video	Embedded ShareFaithKids video	A visual way to explore the story of John 10 and see Jesus' saying in more context of the Bible.
12.45-15.03	Young Person Reflection	Video thoughts from Tom, 16, around what Jesus' I am saying means to him plus follow up thoughts from Nicola	Chance for children to see reflection in practice by another young person.
15.03-16.40	Closing Prayer (Either watch video with voiceover or pause for a child to volunteer to pray to end collective worship.)	Still image embedded into video – words with Nicola narrating	Quiet reflection/personal prayer time in response to session.
16.40-End	Optional Worship song (subject to Covid guidance on singing together – <i>this one is particularly catchy!</i>)	Worship music video – The Baa, Baa Song (He's The Good Shepherd) – Sibling Harmony <i>(embedded into the end of the video)</i>
