Palm Sunday to Good Friday

Let's get creative to mark Holy Week this year. Holy Week runs from Palm Sunday 5th April to Good Friday 10th April. What we would like everybody to do is to make a Palm Cross.

Now you can draw it, colour one in, knit it, make it from wood, clay or things from the garden. The only rule is please don't buy anything new, make it from things you have at home.

You have from now to Good Friday to do it.

From Palm Sunday onwards can you do two things;

1. Take a picture of yourself with your palm cross and post it on our Facebook Page or send you photo to office@bedworthparish.org.
2. Put the cross on your front door or in your window.

The crosses will remind us and our community of Jesus's journey from the celebration and praise he received on Palm Sunday to his horrific death on Good Friday, betrayed and abandoned by those he came to save. The cross is a powerful symbol of the incredible hope we have in Jesus. With our prayers and the power of the Holy Spirit at work in our communities lets be looking for signs of Jesus Kingdom.

A 3pm on Good Friday lets take down our crosses and leave that space blank until Easter Sunday when we can celebrate Jesus rising form the dead and his victory over death.
